

Introducing Article 370 was a historic mistake: Shivraj

Former CM campaigns in support of BJP candidate in Delhi

Bhopal: During a public meeting in support of BJP candidate Yogendra Chandolia from the North-West Delhi seat, former Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan sharply criticized the opposition Congress party and former Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru. He accused them of making a historic mistake by introducing Article 370 in Jammu and Kashmir. Chouhan also slammed Nehru for prematurely calling off the war, suggesting it was a significant error.

In his pointed remarks, Chouhan stated, "It was Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru and the Congress' decision to introduce Article 370 in Jammu and Kashmir, despite Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's opposition. Additionally, the former PM made a historic blunder by declaring a ceasefire when our troops were fighting against



Pakistan. Had he not stopped the war three days early, the entire Kashmir region would be ours, and we would only need to reclaim Pak-

istan-occupied Kashmir (PoK)." He praised Prime Minister Modi and the BJP government for abrogating Article 370.

'We will definitely reclaim PoK'

Chouhan asserted, "The lapses of introducing Articles 370 and 35A by the Congress and former PM Nehru have been rectified by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the BJP government. Now, only PoK remains, and we will definitely reclaim it." Article 370 had granted special status to Jammu and Kashmir, allowing it to have its own constitution and autonomy while restricting Parliament's legislative powers over the state.

Article 35A, which was added to the Constitution in 1954 through an order issued by President Rajendra Prasad under Article 370, empowered Jammu and Kashmir to define permanent residents and grant them special rights and privileges, including the ability to purchase land, receive benefits in healthcare and education, and seek state government jobs.

Kartikeya may contest if Shivraj is elected MP from Vidisha

Bhopal: Former Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh Shivraj Singh Chouhan, who is popular throughout the state as 'Mama' and 'Bhaiya', is currently in the electoral arena from the Vidisha seat in this general election. The Vidisha Lok Sabha seat is considered a stronghold of the BJP, which is why Shivraj Singh Chouhan's victory on this seat is being considered certain. Now, the question arises whether Kartikey Singh Chouhan, son of Shivraj Singh Chouhan who is currently MLA from Budhni, will be given a ticket once his father's seat in Budhni becomes vacant. Student attacked with knife after dispute, 3 held

Bhopal: A B. Tech student had a dispute with three youths in Anand Nagar area of the city. Within a short time, a fight broke out between them. Meanwhile, the youth took out a knife and attacked the B.Tech student. The student got injured due to this. After receiving information about the incident, the police registered a case under sections of attempt to murder and arrested the accused.

According to Piplani police, Satyam Namdev, resident of Ashok Vihar Colony, is a second year B.Tech student in a private college. On Monday night he was returning from the library with his friends. On the way near Rishipuram Colony on Hathaikheda Road, three youths stopped him and started abusing him. When Satyam refused to stop abusing them, the youth started beating him. Meanwhile, a

young man attacked Satyam with a knife. As soon as information about the incident was received, the police reached the spot and started investigation. Satyam was taken to the hospital for treatment. Here, the police have arrested the accused after registering a case of attempt to murder. Their names are Hritikh, Rajkumar and Prince. The police are interrogating them.

Burqa-clad women commit loot at knife point

In Aishbagh area, burqa-clad women entered the house of a man, held a knife to his wife and four-year-old innocent child and looted Rs 2.5 lakh in cash and jewellery. The incident occurred on May 8, but the victim's family informed the police on May 22. After receiving the com-

plaint, the police has started investigation. However, the police are finding the entire story suspicious as no woman is visible in the CCTV footage.

According to Sub-Inspector Ganpat Singh posted at Aishbagh police station, Ejaz Aziz lives in Housing Board Colony. He supports his family by renting a house. He told in his complaint that he had gone to the mosque to offer Namaz at around 7 pm on May 8th.

During this time, apart from his wife Mary, his 13 year old daughter and four year old son were present in the house. Then four women wearing burqa came and started talking about the rent

of the house. After this, when the women asked for water to drink, Ejaz's wife called them inside the house. As soon as they entered the house, the women took out a knife and thrust it at Ejaz's wife and asked for the keys of the cupboard. When the woman protested, the other woman held a knife to the throat of the four-year-old child. Frightened by this, Ejaz's wife gave the keys. After this, the accused women looted Rs 2.5 lakh in cash and gold and silver jewelry kept in the cupboard. Police are investigating the matter.
